NEW RACE CATEGORIES

Two exciting new race classes have been introduced that recognise the breadth of masters rowing engagement. We look forward to seeing these become firm fixtures in future regatta programmes.

Masters Recreational Social Events: These events are a social grade of racing over 500m. You may be returning to rowing after a lengthy break, or you might be an existing master rower who has limited training opportunity. Note: *Competitive rowers are expected to enter the 1000m events*.

New Masters Events: These events are for people that started racing after January 2021 i.e. rowers in their first five years of racing.

Note: This Racing Grade excludes competitors that have had Age-Group podium finishes at NI, SI or National Masters Events or raced Club Grade Events in the last 2 years.

ROWIT, CONDITIONS & ENTRY DATES

REGATTA CENTRAL

Mahinapua Hotel is host to both the after-race socialising on Friday 25th and the Prizegiving and Celebration function on the following night. A short 10 minutes south of Hokitika, and almost equidistant from Hans Bay, the hotel is a West Coast icon.

 - 1x Family room, with 2 bedrooms one with Queen bed, one with 2 bunk beds -Ensuite bathroom. \$250/night.
 - 2x 4-bed dorms with bunk beds. Shared Bathroom. \$40 per bed per night or \$160 to secure 1 full room.
